LOCAL LAW # C- A LOCAL LAW TO OVERRIDE THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW §3-c (For Introductory Purposes)

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR THANE

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Amsterdam as follows:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

It is the intent of this local law to allow the City of Amsterdam to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2012, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

SECTION 2. SUBSTANTIVE PROVISIONS

TAX LEVY LIMIT OVERRIDE

The Common Council of the City of Amsterdam is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2012, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

Should any section or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole or any parts thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. ENABLING LEGISLATION

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which authorizes the override of the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the total voting power of the governing body.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE
